General Rules and Guidelines

The rules are intended to promote safe and fair competition within the ideals of good sportsmanship and are based upon Proposed PCA Parade Rules for 2021. See Metro NY PCA Autocross 2016 Rules and Guidelines for additional information. It is each driver's responsibility to read, understand and observe the rules.

Event entrance fee is \$35.00 for PCA members, \$50.00 for non-members; **a \$10.00 surcharge will be added for late registration**. Non-PCA Member registration shall be limited to 15 drivers, or at the discretion of the Autocross Chairman. Participants must arrive on time and register prior to the published close of registration. Entrance fee must be paid by all participants and is non-refundable.

The following minimum requirements must be met to run:

- ✓ All drivers shall be 18 years of age and possess a valid driver's license.
- ✓ Sons and daughters of PCA members 16/17 years of age that possess a valid full driver's license may participate in the Junior Participation Program (JPP).
- ✓ A driver may only enter (1) car per event with a maximum of (2) drivers per car.
- ✓ All cars must pass an on-site tech inspection. Cars that do not pass tech will not run.
- ✓ All drivers **must** complete both morning and afternoon work assignments.
- ✓ All drivers and instructors must wear helmets. Helmets must be Snell 2005 approved or newer M or SA.
- ✓ Official car number shall be clearly marked in contrasting color (min 5" tall) on both sides of the car.
- ✓ All drivers and instructors must wear seatbelts or safety harnesses.
- ✓ Open toed shoes, sandals and bare feet are not permitted. Rubber-soled shoes are recommended.
- ✓ Loose objects inside the trunk, passenger compartment and glove box must be removed from the car.
- ✓ No speeding in the pit or paddock area or within the general vicinity of the event. No tire warming.
- ✓ Roll bars are recommended for cabriolets, roll bar extensions for Boxsters.

Any questions? Please speak to the Chairman or any member of the Autocross Committee.

- No alcoholic beverages or drugs are permitted at the event.
- An adult must accompany children at all times. Dogs must be leashed. No dogs are allowed at Tobay.
- If you see a dangerous condition, immediately report it to the Chairman, Safety Advisor or Control.
- The addition of safety equipment is permitted and strongly recommended.
- Any driver that damages equipment will compensate MNYPCA for the cost of repair/replacement.

Remember, we are here to have fun, enjoy the day, and become better drivers. Good Luck and BE SAFE.

Any conduct at an Autocross event considered by Metro NY PCA Region to be either unsafe or inconsistent with the spirit or purpose of the Autocross Program will not be permitted. The Metro NY PCA Autocross Chairman and Committee reserves the right to immediately suspend driving privileges or refuse entry to any participant that cannot abide by the rules whether stated herein or otherwise implied.

Any driver that cannot adhere to the rules will be disqualified and asked to leave.
