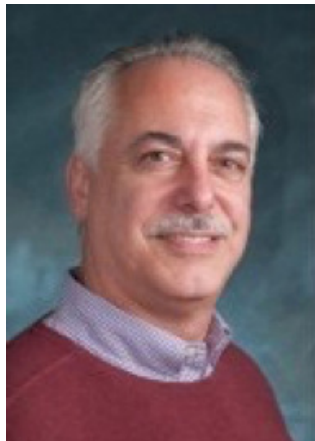

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Track Ramblings

FRED PACK - DE INSTRUCTOR



Manual vs. PDK

This is largely an opinion piece.

I am not going to discuss the eternal question, “Which is better, Manual or PDK?” For one thing, there isn’t AN answer, since everything about driving is a question of taste and preference; for another, this topic has been beaten to death and beyond on discussion boards and at

bars worldwide. What I am going to do is to present some high-level information and viewpoints on the issue.

In the USA barely anyone buys cars with manual gearboxes any longer. Only 2.4% of the 2020 USA sales were manuals. (Worldwide the amount was a much higher 40%; Cost reasons, for both initial expense and upkeep are the reason.) Sports car drivers are also abandoning the manual gearbox, although at a lower rate.

US car sales in 2020 were 14.6 million; Porsche US sales were 57,294. Porsche thus represented .39% of the cars sold – or about 1 in every 250. Porsche has said that 70% of GT3 sales are with manual gearboxes.

A non-opinion assertion is that the PDK-type gearbox is ‘better’ than a manual gearbox in at least two ways: It shifts faster, including full-power upshifts, and it is less tiring to use, particularly in stop-and-go traffic.

To get started, “PDK”, which was introduced in the 2009 model year, is the abbreviation for the German language “Porsche-Doppelkupplungsgetriebe”, which translates into “Porsche Double Clutch Transmission”. The benefit of this type of transmission for high-performance cars is 2-fold: (1) the driver can focus on the actual driving, rather than shifting gears; (2) less time is spent off-power than with an ordinary automatic or regular manual shifter.

The proof that the PDK-type gearbox is a higher-performance component than the manual type is that all F1 cars have used them since 1993. (Ferrari was the first, with the 1990 introduction of their F1 cars.)

Porsche is one of the few high-end manufacturers that

continue to offer cars with manual gearboxes, and even they only do so on the sportscars – 911 and Boxster/ Cayman. Macans and Cayennes are only available with PDK. Taycons have an automatic 2-speed transmission. Ferrari, Lamborghini, McLaren and Maseratis only come with automatic transmissions. (In the high-performance arena other than Porsche, only Lotus, Aston Martin, BMW, and Mustang continue to offer manual gearbox cars. Even the new mid-engine Corvette is only available with a PDK-like gearbox.)

In preparing to write this article, I consulted with various industry, racing, and technical experts to get their observations. Some of what they had to say is controversial and potentially upsetting, so I am keeping their names private. Here goes:

Since it is clear that the PDK-type gearbox is objectively better for high-performance driving than the traditional manual, why does Porsche still offer the manual? There is a simple answer for that: customer demand. Many Porsche drivers want to shift their own gears – I count myself as one of them. All three of my post-2009 Porsche sportscars have been manual. All businesses pay close attention to the desires of their customers – if enough of them want a triple-shot caramel latte with banana and kumquat, the coffee shop will be sure it’s on the menu. And yet Porsche, for all their marketing savvy, made a major blunder in 2014 when they launched the 991 GT3 with PDK only – no manual was offered. They assumed that the ‘engineering mentality’ expressed by “The PDK is faster than the manual. The GT3 is our most popular track-ready car. Of course it should only be equipped with the PDK” would be validated by the customer base. But the customers rose up in outrage. “We want – no, we insist on – the option of a manual gearbox in our GT3s”. Porsche relented and both gearboxes have been offered ever since 2018 for GT3s.

And so, life was good – Porsche sports cars could be had with either the PDK or manual gearboxes. There was one holdout, though: the 911 Turbo, which is PDK only. This question – why no manual on the 911 Turbo – nagged me and was the basis for me reaching out to the experts I mentioned above. I got back a range of replies and opinions, which I’ll summarize here:

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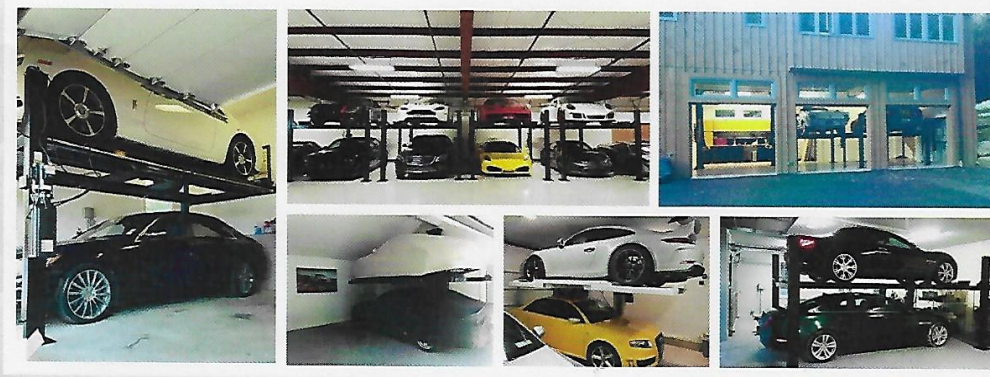
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Be On Time

Typically there will be one or two sets of instructions that are written specifically for this rally and there will be questions and/or directions that relate to these instructions written for the purpose of tricking the participants. The lesson is: read and study the "General Instructions" before leaving the parking lot – it's worth at least one correct answer.

Two teams tied with a score of 24 correct out of 30: Mitch Hackett & Dan Fishkind and Mark Cimino & Barbara Puskiewicz-Cimino. Well done!

- The mandatory new model government crash-testing is very expensive, and the manual is considered a different model than the PDK for that testing. In view of the low volume of the 911 Turbo, Porsche decided to offer only the PDK.
- For decades, the number one statistic people consider for proof of performance is the 0-60mph time. The PDK car gets to 60 faster than the manual model. The competition from Ferrari, Lamborghini, McLaren, etc, all offer only PDK-type gearboxes. In order for Porsche to stay with the fastest, bye-bye manual Porsche Turbo! Bragging rights are important.
- The PDK eliminates any possibility of over-revving the engine on downshifts, which is otherwise a risk on these very high-powered cars.
- A number of the experts cited fuel consumption and emissions control as a reason for offering only the PDK on the 911 Turbo. I don't quite understand that point, but it was raised by them.
- A PCNA (Porsche Cars North America) person had this to say:

A lot of things go into what transmission is offered for each model; in particular the 911 Turbo is influenced by performance numbers, a luxury build and customer preference for this model. Whenever we want a car to go really fast, (Turbo S, GT2RS, GT3RS etc...) we fit a PDK.

I believe the PDK is a much more robust option as well compared to a manual especially for a high output, all-wheel drive beast with repeatable sub 3 second 0-60 times. If you look at some other models that offer both transmissions, especially in the mid-engine offerings, the PDK [version]

has slightly higher torque numbers.

After putting a lot of miles on the latest 992 GT3 Touring and 992 911 GTS manual transmissions, I believe Porsche has one of the most refined and smoothest shifting manuals out there, the cars that do offer the manual are definitely a pleasure to drive.

- The nature of the GT2/3 versus Turbo driver is different. One of the experts expressed it this way:

The GT car buyers are car drivers; the Turbo buyers are car owners.

That is, the two-arm-two-foot interface is crucial to any driving experience. GT cars do track day outings.

The one-hand-on-the-wheel-the-other-hand-on: pick one: girlfriend's knee, coffee, audio system, or.... and one-foot for the pedals fits the Turbo customers. Turbos do country club outings.

911 Turbo track drivers may(?) want to dispute that expert's assessment, which is why I'm keeping his name to myself. (I certainly do see some of them moving right along at the track.)

That about wraps it up for now in the PDK versus manual wars.

I took the newly restored Carrera to Starbucks in New Canaan, CT, above right. Can we figure out how to put a "force field" around the car so no one bangs into it? One of our favorite cars currently in the shop is this 356 Carrera. While a stock 356 Carrera 2 is an excellent road driving car, the owner was looking for vintage race performance. The original engine and transmission were removed, stored and replaced with a special close ratio five-speed gearbox and 904 racing engine with the factory power upgrade. As compared to the original four speed, the tighter gear spacing helps the 170 horsepower engine stay on cam and deliver performance that is impressive even by today's standards.

From back roads to the back straight, no matter which Porsche you drive, or how you want to drive it, we'll help you get the most from it. Because your vision of excellence is the one that matters.

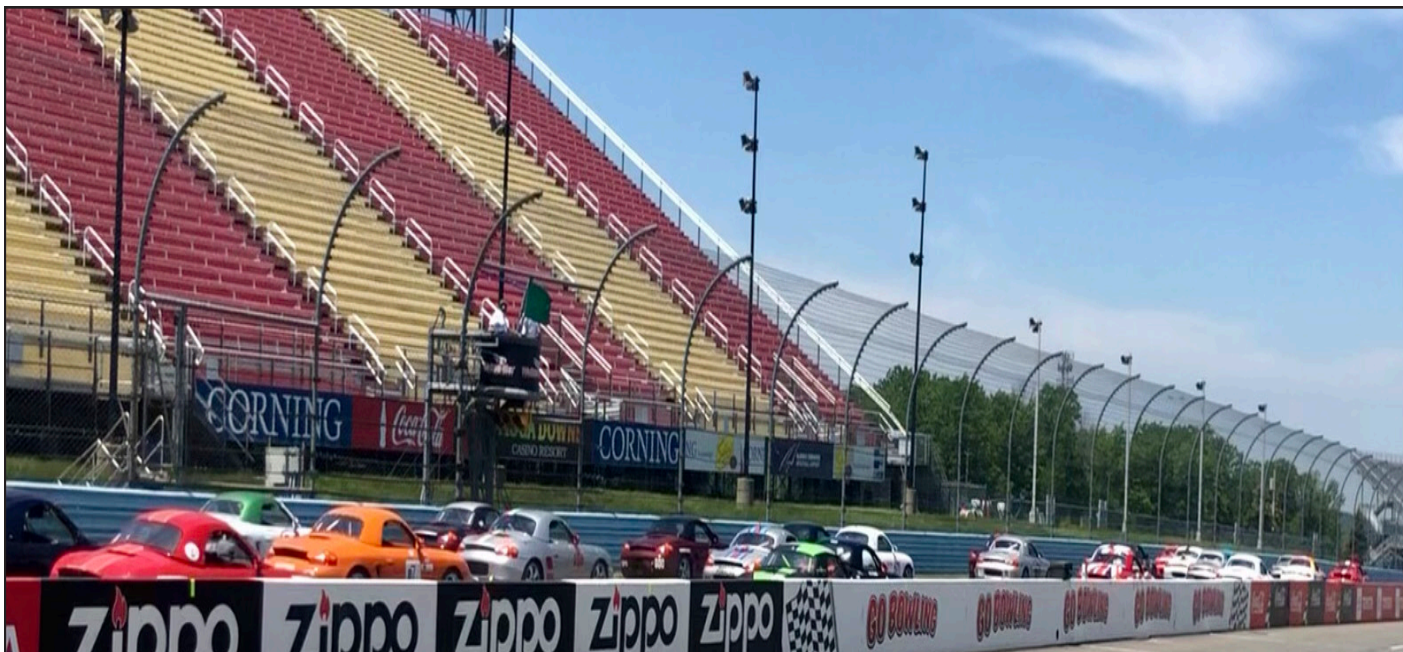

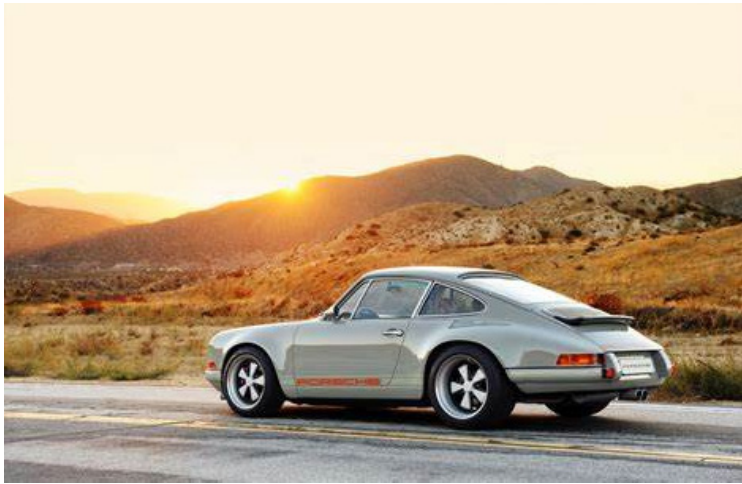

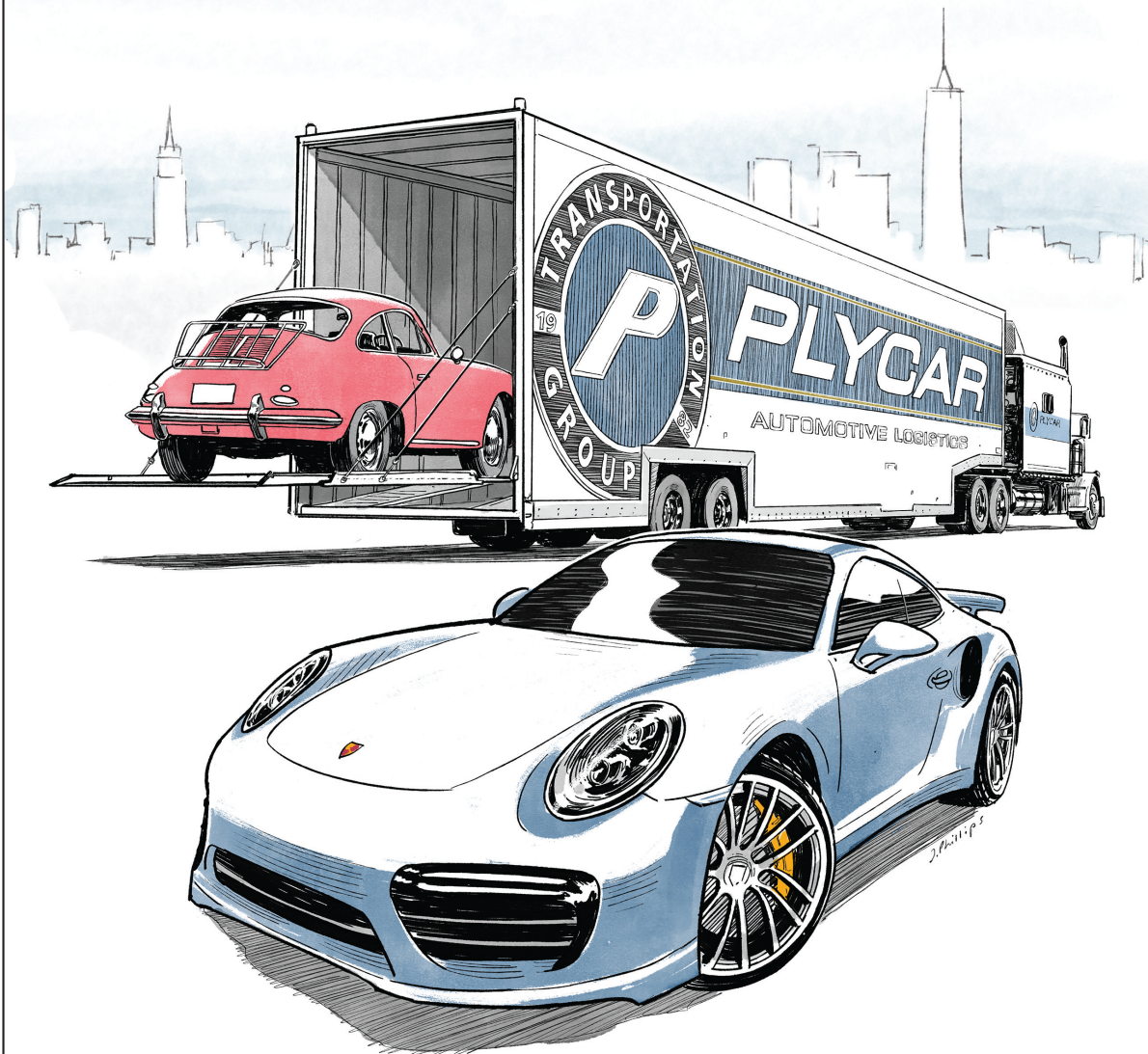
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
